The ISO rating for all portions of Fallbrook and Bonsall is a '5' and for Rainbow a '9'. If you are interested in determining response time and travel distance, please utilize mapquest or similar mapping software to determine distance from each location. Response time is calculated at 30 mph. For example, a fire station 2 miles away would have a 4 min. response time.

Inasmuch as we cannot guarantee availability of apparatus, we do not provide second or third due response times. This too may be determined by using mapquest or similar software.

All stations equipped with a triple combination pumper (engine), with a 500 gal. water capacity.

The District requires 100' native vegetation (brush) clearance and clearing of all seasonal weeds and grasses. We do not require or enforce clearance beyond this distance.

If additional information is required, the District charges \$138.34 for a site inspection with a written response.
